**Kenneth Cox**, better known as Ken Cox, served the ABA in many different positions. He joined the ABA at the age of 19 and came in winning! He won the National Open Pairs at age 20; he was a charter member of the Henry C. Parker Jr. Bridge Club; Greater New York Bridge Council; founder and editor of the MBAU, The Bridge Consumer; an organizer of the MBU, and later VO; Eastern Section Vice President for two terms; National Chairman Planning Committee; 1958 Nationals; National Convention Manager; National Tournament Committee; Executive Secretary of the ABA for over ten years; National Vice President of the ABA; member of the ABA Task Force which successfully concluded negotiation for reciprocal recognition of master point holdings between the ACBL and the ABA. Because of his fantasticness, an award was named for him in 1999 under Past President Cleo Terrell\* (of Chicago) in 1999.

The Kenneth Cox award was patterned after the ACBL's Von Zedtwitz and Blackwood awards, honoring bridge-playing expertise and to the game of bridge outside of their bridge expertise." One often must choose between playing, honing, competing, amassing points or serving the Association, Ken had proved himself as a bridge player: in the Top Ten, in the Top Twenty, panelist on "Bidding Is Klear Kut," authored by Roscoe Rigmaiden and Luis Pietri, and winner of many local, sectional and national events.

The first recipient was Lt. Col. Robert A. Friend who was presented the Cox Medallion by Kenneth Cox, himself, as a standing ovation and thunderous applause greeted Ken. Posthumously, James "Jimmy" Lee was so honored. [Bob Friend was the first winner of the "Friend Award" before it was called the William Friend Award in 1955. When his father died, Bob asked that the award for most points in a year be named in honor of his father.]

Other winners include: Art Wills\*, Detroit, MI in 2001; George Johnson\*, Charlotte, NC in 2002; and Mae Clark of Arlington, TX and Lionel Barton of Houston, TX in 2003. Since that time, there have been no further awards given. (Excerpts from Defining Moments, a 70 Year Chronicle of the American Bridge Association.

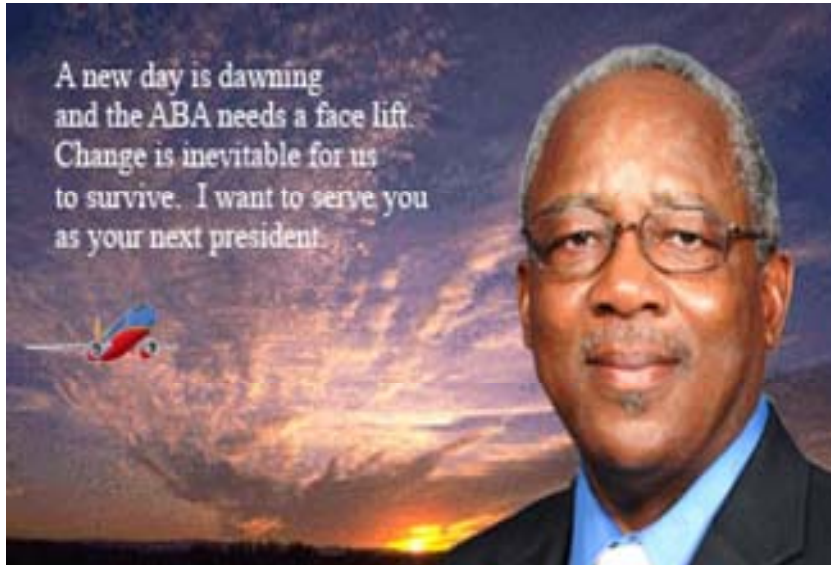
