# The Entry Slip

It is **VERY IMPORTANT** that this slip be completed correctly. It is also important to purchase your entry **ON TIME** and be seated at the table **ON TIME**. The most important thing on the entry slip is your **ABA NUMBER**. Most scorers put your name in by number. So, make sure you write your number down correctly. You should have some labels made with your number printed and in that way, you'll always be right. You should also make sure your partner's number is also correct. Always check the press sheet at the end of the game to be sure your name is recorded correctly. If you transpose two numbers, you are somebody else! Even if you are using the **BRIDGE MATES**, you still need to complete your entry slip.

Did you know that the **COLOR** or your entry slip matches the color of your **TABLE MARKER**? Your tickets also match (usually). So, Section A is **WHITE**, B is **YELLOW**, C is **GREEN**, D is **ORANGE**, E is **BLUE**, and F is **PINK**. Knowing this will save you time in locating your seat. The **NORTH** position usually is turned toward the director's table. In some club games it is turned toward the North in that city. According to the **BOOK**, **NORTH** should face the Director.

Once you have purchased your entry, fill it out and write the name of the Game, the time of the game, your pair number and your direction on the **INSIDE** of your Convention Card. By doing that, if you have a question later about the score, you can ask questions intelligently. **EXAMPLE**: "I was sitting 6 E-W on Saturday at 1:30 PM in Section H."
